

#### **Describe Your Artwork/Performance Style:**

Sculpture/eclectic mix of style. The art world is my oyster.

#### When did you start making your art? Why?

I've always been a creative type. As a kid I was always doodling or trying different crafts. My art teacher in high school was very rigid and when we received projects to do they were always follow instructions A-Z. That never really fit my style so around that time was when I really let my imagination and creativity run wild. Now as an adult it's really a way to create something that just makes me happy. I do my art for myself and to find a sense of accomplishment. It's most satisfying when this idea you've brainstormed can become a "living" thing.

#### What is your inspiration?

Pop culture has been a big inspiration for me. Growing up with tons of brand logos, characters, and celebrities that seem almost too big for real life has given my art a surreal kind of edge.

#### Do you make a living with your art?

I would be living the dream if that was a possibility. Sadly no paycheck, but I have donated several skate decks and other types of my art to the local community for fundraisers.

#### What are your current non-art jobs?

I have been working at Chesapeake Hearing Centers for three years now. Starting off as a front office staff and now currently working towards becoming a hearing aid dispenser.

#### Who is your favorite artist and why?

My favorite artist is Frank Kozik. In the 80's he made these punk rock posters for some bands you may have heard of: The Beastie Boys, Green Day, and Nirvana. Then in the early 2000's he designed a line of'art toys" featuring many pop culture influences. He has such a punk rock attitude in his art that he literally has no boundaries for what he will make next. How could I not love him?

# Proposed changes to the Constitution and By Laws

The following changes to the Constitution and the ByLaws will be voted on at the meeting on October 4 (deletions strike through—additions underline).

#### Constitution

#### Article III - Membership

Section A - There shall be four <u>three</u> (4 <u>3</u>) classes of membership: (1) Individual (2) Family (couples or families); <u>and</u> (3) Lifetime ; and (4) Student.

#### **Article VI - Elections**

Section A - Nominations for officers and Board of Directors positions shall be held at the regular general membership meeting in April May of each year and notice thereof shall be published in the March April newsletter.

Section B - The President shall appoint a nominating committee which shall submit the names of candidates for the various offices of Players at the April May meeting.

Section C - An election shall be held on the first Wednesday of May of <u>at the June meeting</u> each year and notice thereof shall be published in the April May newsletter.

Section D - All officers shall be elected annually and shall take office at the June membership meeting on July 1

Section F - Absentee ballots shall be mailed to all members as part of the April May newsletter.
